

The Quality Assurance Consultant will oversee all GLP (hematology/clinical chemistry/histopathology) studies to ensure compliance with the standard procedures and specific protocols so that no deviations occur without proper authorization. He or she will report significant problems that are likely to affect the integrity of a study to the Study Director and management.
